



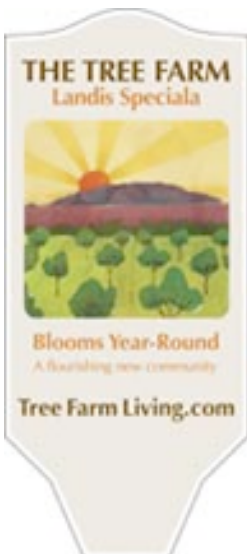
More Progress at The Tree Farm – Landscaping Moves Forward
